

ON REFLECTION...

Readings: Is 66.10-14; Ps 65; Gal 6.14-18; Lk 10. 1-12, 17-20

Our Holy Mass today is a joyful one. The homely first reading is really encouraging. The psalm is equally positive. Its final verse is so natural - recognising that God does not withhold his love. But today read the Preface and really rejoice!

St Paul tells his critics where to go while boasting his rejection of the secular culture of his day.

The tension between our life style and what scripture and spiritual writers call 'the world' is an issue for all who love God. God loves the world, he made it. We disapprove of those whose lives cannot be called godly but God loves us all.

Jesus was sent to save sinners. He was also sent to save the world. Jesus loves the world. Those mystics with whom he reportedly discussed his life report how much he loved the little house at Nazareth. To the annoyance of many hard pressed mothers he thought the lily was better dressed than Solomon!

Jesus is not a fool. He knows what is in man and he knows what men do to men, even to men bringing good news. But he comes to save fools who reject him and his good news. That is his reason for being in the world with us. His world is not an ideal, it contains us and worse than us.

Yet he sends the likes of us to go ahead of him. Zachery talked of his son, John, preparing 'the ways of the Lord.' That, too, is our vocation to prepare our families and communities for the promised visitation and redemption mentioned by Zachery in the lovely *Benedictus*.
